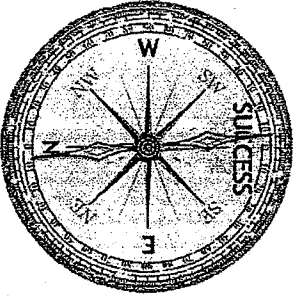


RESOURCES FOR LOCAL NEEDS

GOCCP provides access to federal and state grant funds and we can provide assistance to your town, city, or county as it attempts to maneuver through the red tape to tap these resources.

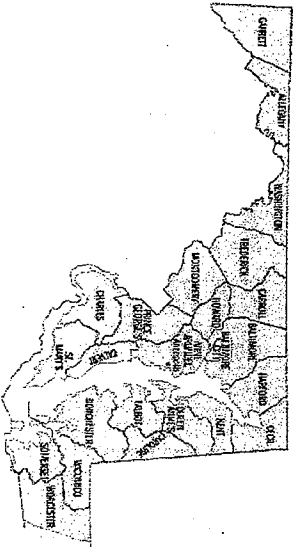


GOCCP works with you to plan your project, coordinate stakeholders, develop accountability measures, and get results from your investments and efforts.

THE RESPONSE

In 1995, Executive Order 01.01.1995.18 established the Governor's Office of Crime Control & Prevention (GOCCCP) by merging the Governor's Drug and Alcohol Abuse Commission and the Governor's Office of Justice Administration. In 2005, Executive Order 01.01.2005.36 empowered GOCCCP to develop collaborative and deliberate approaches to impact crime through more effective management of Maryland's criminal justice resources. In February 2007, Executive Order 01.01.2007.04 placed Maryland's Statistical Analysis Center within GOCCCP to facilitate statewide crime data analysis and sharing to generate effective local policies and solutions.

THE RESOURCE

The Governor's Office of Crime Control & Prevention (GOCCCP) meets Maryland's public safety challenges with the highest level of customer service in grants administration, technical assistance, collaboration, crime data analysis, and statewide distribution of public safety research, statistics, and best practices.

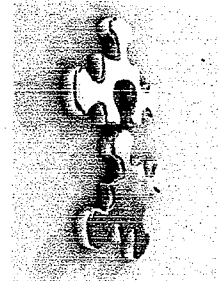
